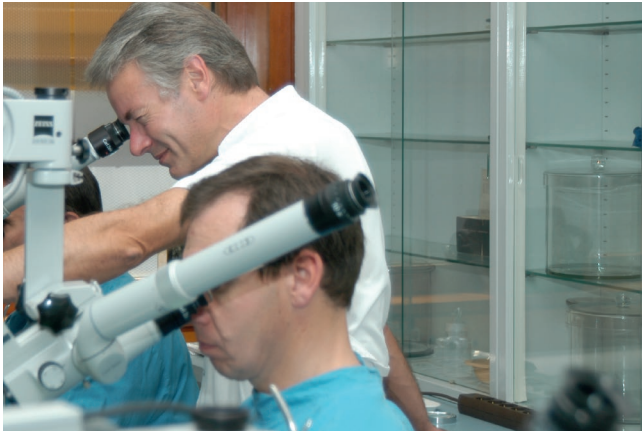

Dear Colleagues,

Voice restoration can be offered by a variety of techniques of phonosurgery. Large anatomical and functional defects up to total laryngeal loss require advanced techniques of reconstructive surgery including microsurgical free tissue transfer and electric laryngeal pacing.



The Wuerzburg Workshop is offered under the auspices of the European Laryngological Society (ELS) and the European Study Group for Functional Laryngology (EGFL). Using modern high definition 3D technology, live surgeries from two operating theaters cover the complete spectrum of phonosurgery. Hands-on training under expert guidance is offered in the skills lab. Basic knowledge as well as diagnostic and therapeutic details are presented and discussed by international experts.

This year's topics focus on overcoming the sequelae of therapy and include

- ▶ functional electric stimulation of the larynx
- ▶ reconstructive measures including use of prefabricated flaps
- ▶ state of the art laryngeal tissue engineering
- ▶ autotransplantation of salivary glands for irradiated patients
- ▶ concepts for the use of Botulinum toxin

We are looking forward to welcoming you in Wuerzburg and to experiencing a scientifically and personally enriching meeting.
